

ALUMNI LECTURE REPORT – AUGUST 2025

Topic: Meningitis

Date: 18.08.2025

Venue: Lecture Theatre II

Introduction

The SGRRIM&HS, College of Nursing organized an Alumni Lecture on the topic "Meningitis" on 18.08.2025 at 12 pm. Dr. Manish Kumar Mishra (President Alumni Association, SGRR University), Prof. Dr. G. Ramalakshmi (Dean, SGRR College of Nursing) and Dr. Ponmari. K, Professor (Alumni Coordinator, SGRR College of Nursing) was organized the alumni lecture programme with the warm welcome of our Guest speaker Mrs. Iris George Dennis. The guest speaker for the session was an esteemed alumnus of our institution, currently working as Assistant Professor, Doon Institute of Medical Science (DIMS), Dehradun. The lecture was conducted with the objective of enhancing the knowledge of students regarding meningitis, its clinical aspects, and recent advancements in its management.

Overview of the Lecture

The resource person began the session by highlighting the importance of early recognition and management of meningitis. The lecture covered the following key areas:

- 1. **Definition and Epidemiology** Understanding meningitis as an inflammation of the meninges caused by bacterial, viral, fungal, or parasitic infections.
- 2. **Etiology** Common causative organisms such as *Neisseria meningitidis*, *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, and *Haemophilus influenzae*.

- 3. **Pathophysiology** The mechanism of infection spread, inflammation, and its effect on the central nervous system.
- 4. **Types of Meningitis** Bacterial, viral, fungal, and aseptic meningitis.
- 5. Clinical Manifestations Signs and symptoms such as fever, headache, neck stiffness, photophobia, seizures, and altered sensorium.
- 6. **Diagnosis** Importance of CSF examination, imaging, and laboratory tests.
- 7. **Treatment Modalities** Use of antibiotics, antivirals, antifungals, corticosteroids, and supportive care.
- 8. **Prevention** Role of vaccination, early treatment of infections, and public health measures.
- 9. **Nursing Management** Monitoring neurological status, maintaining airway, fluid balance, and infection prevention.
- 10. **Recent Advances** New vaccines, rapid diagnostic methods, and improved critical care strategies.

Interaction Session

The lecture was followed by an interactive Q&A session, where students actively clarified their doubts regarding clinical assessment, differential diagnosis, and preventive strategies. The alumni speaker also shared personal clinical experiences in handling meningitis cases, which enriched the session.

Outcome of the Session

- Enhanced student knowledge on the epidemiology, pathophysiology, and management of meningitis.
- Provided practical insights into patient care and preventive measures.
- Motivated students to keep updated with current clinical practices and research.

Conclusion
