The Mental Health Nursing Department organized Music Meditation and Relaxation Therapy in the evening session as part of the Nurses Week celebrations.

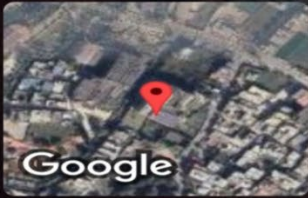

The session was highly appreciated and highlighted the importance of mental health and self-care in both academic and professional life.





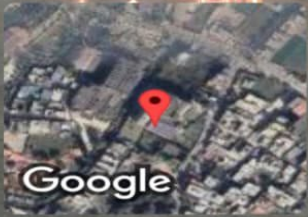

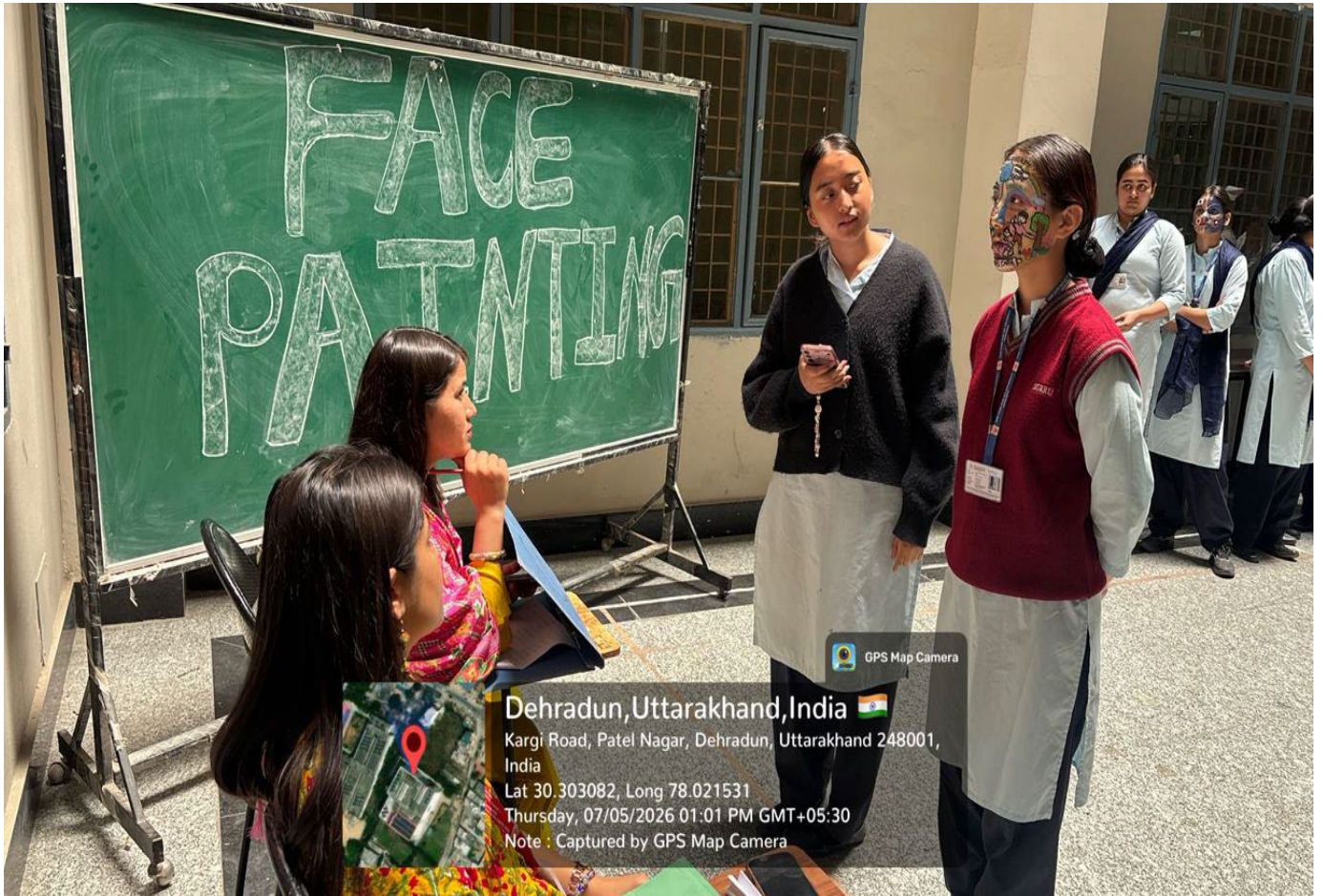
FACE PAINTING COMPETITION
