Introduction

The School of Education at SGRR University, in collaboration with the Azim Premji Foundation, conducted a three-day workshop on **Research Methodology and Action Research** for teachers of SGRR Public School. The workshop aimed to enhance teachers' understanding of research techniques, data analysis, and the application of action research in classroom settings to improve teaching-learning processes.

Objectives of the Workshop

 - Basic data analysis techniques (using Excel and simple statistical tools).
 - Interpreting findings and making evidence-based decisions.
 - Structuring an action research report.
- **Presentation & Feedback:** Participants presented their action research plans and received constructive feedback from facilitators.
- **Valedictory Session:** Certificates were distributed, and teachers shared their key takeaways from the workshop.

Outcomes & Feedback

- Teachers gained confidence in integrating research into their teaching practices.
- Participants developed actionable research plans to address classroom challenges.
- Positive feedback highlighted the workshop's interactive and practical approach.

कार्यशाला के प्रमुख बिंदु.


- कार्यशाला के प्रमुख बिंदुओं में एक्शन रिसर्च और रिसर्च मेथडोलॉजी शामिल थे। कार्यशाला के प्रथम चरण में श्री विनय कुमार चौहान ने अजीम प्रेमजी फाउंडेशन के कार्यों के बारे में विस्तार से बताया, जिसमें बच्चों की शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य और आजीविका के क्षेत्र में किए जा रहे कार्य शामिल हैं।

Workshop on Research Methodology & Action Research

Conducted by: School of Education, SGRR University & Azim Premji Foundation

For: SGRR Public School Teachers

Objective:

To provide hands-on experience in understanding the fundamentals of research, including problem identification, literature review, and research design.

Activity Structure:

1. Group Discussion & Brainstorming (30 mins)

- Teachers were divided into small groups (4-5 members each).
- Each group identified a common classroom challenge (e.g., low student participation, ineffective assessment methods, lack of digital literacy).
- Guided questions:
 - *What is the problem?*
 - *Why is it important to solve?*
 - *How can research help address it?*

2. Developing a Mini Research Proposal (60 mins)

- Each group structured a basic research outline using a template:
 - **Title:** (e.g., "*Improving Student Engagement Through Interactive Learning Techniques*")
 - **Research Problem:** Clear statement of the issue.
 - **Objectives:** 2-3 key goals.
 - **Methodology:**
 - *Data Collection:* Surveys, observations, student feedback.
 - *Participants:* Class/grade level.
 - **Expected Outcomes:** How findings could improve teaching.

3. Peer Review & Feedback (30 mins)

- Groups exchanged proposals and provided constructive feedback.
- Key focus areas:

- Clarity of the research problem.
- Feasibility of methodology.
- Practical relevance to classroom needs.

4. **Facilitator's Summary & Key Takeaways (30 mins)**

- Common pitfalls in research design (e.g., vague objectives, biased data collection).
- Importance of ethical considerations (consent, confidentiality).
- Resources for further learning (books, online tools from Azim Premji Foundation).

Outcome:

- Teachers gained confidence in framing research questions.
- Practical understanding of linking classroom issues to research-based solutions.
- Collaborative learning through peer feedback.

Next Steps: Teachers refined their proposals for Day 3's session on *Action Research Implementation*.

Topic: Action Research & Research Methodology

The final day of the workshop focused on **participant presentations, peer discussions, and expert feedback** on action research plans developed during the previous sessions.

Key Activities:

1. **Presentation of Action Research Proposals**

- Teachers presented their draft action research plans in small groups.

- Each presentation included:
 - **Research Title & Problem Statement** (e.g., "Improving Student Participation in Science Discussions")
 - **Objectives & Methodology** (data collection tools like surveys, observations)
 - **Expected Outcomes & Implementation Strategy**

2. Peer Feedback Session

- Participants engaged in constructive discussions, suggesting improvements on:
 - Clarity of research questions
 - Feasibility of data collection methods
 - Potential challenges and solutions

3. Expert Review & Recommendations

- Facilitators from **SGRR University** and **Azim Premji Foundation** provided inputs on:
 - Strengthening research design
 - Ethical considerations in classroom research
 - Ways to document and disseminate findings

4. Open House Discussion

- Common themes emerged, such as:
 - Addressing learning gaps through targeted interventions.
 - Using technology for formative assessments.
 - Enhancing student motivation through participatory methods.

5. Way Forward & Implementation Plan

- Teachers finalized timelines for executing their action research projects.
- Plans were made for follow-up sessions to review progress.

Outcome:

- Teachers left with **refined, actionable research plans** ready for implementation.
- The collaborative discussion fostered a deeper understanding of **evidence-based teaching practices**.



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
