Minutes of Meeting of Honourable Vice Chancellor with Principals of Constituent Colleges of University held on 04thOctober, 2018 at 03:00 P.M. at Seminar Room, SGRRU Campus

Dr. A. K. Mehta, Principal- SGRRIM&HS & Dr. Suchit Kumar, Principal- SGRR College of Paramedical Sciences could not attend the meeting.

At the outset, the Honourable Vice Chancellor welcomed all and apprised them about the objectives of the meeting. He once again laid stress on the proactive role of the leadership team of the University for creating an excellent work culture and underlined the effective role of Principals of various constituent colleges in fulfilling the vision of the University and creating newer benchmarks.

Proceeding ahead, the Honourable Vice Chancellor invited Pro Vice Chancellor to initiate the proceedings of the day.

The Pro Vice Chancellor thanked the Honourable Vice Chancellor and once again welcomed all. Initiating the proceedings, the Pro Vice Chancellor informed the gathering that the agenda items for the day's meeting were duly circulated in advance with a request to furnish desired information in hard and soft format. The desired details have been received from Principals of College of Pharmaceutical Science, Management and CA & IT only. The Pro Vice Chancellor



once again requested all Principals to provide their support in building the University by providing all information in time.

The Honourable Vice Chancellor called upon all Principals to develop a robust College under their leadership. He further informed all that if need be, Principals can place a request of a Contingency Fund to manage their day to day petty expenses, if they have not been allotted the same.

Moving ahead, the Pro Vice Chancellor initiated deliberations on various agenda points.

She stressed on the need of maintaining high standards of discipline amongst students and faculty alike. She further underlined that discipline is of paramount importance for the development of Colleges and the University as a whole. She once again reiterated on factors like punctuality, timely conduct of classes, uniform etc. for developing a vibrant culture. She further added that it is the prime duty of the Principals and the teaching faculty to ascertain that all academic activities are conducted smoothly and efficiently. Student attendance, their general behavior needs to be monitored regularly, documented and communicated in advance to guardians and University authorities in case of regular defaulters.

Honourable Vice Chancellor laid emphasis on developing the culture of discipline in all constituent colleges and requested all Principals to lead by example. He further asked all Principals to ensure professional dress code amongst the teaching faculty and staff.

Pro Vice Chancellor enquired on the constitution of various committees like Discipline Committee, Anti Ragging Committee, Student Councils etc. at the college level and urged the principals to utilize the existing manpower and students for achieving the desired goals and objectives. Honourable Vice Chancellor intervened and asked all to submit the details of the Committees to the office of Registrar for documentation and further necessary action. He directed the Registrar to provide the summary chart bearing the names and contact details of all Committee Members (College level Committees) to the office of Honourable Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor.

He further informed the house that University Disciplinary Committee, Proctorial Board and Internal Complaints Committee have been constituted. He enquired about the University Anti Ragging Committee and directed the Registrar to constitute the Committee along with the Committee to redress SC/ST Grievances within 10 days. The Controller of Examination Dr. Ankur Singhal suggested that information about the members of Anti Ragging Committee along with their mobile numbers should be displayed at prominent places in all Constituent Colleges of the University.



Taking the deliberations ahead, the Pro Vice Chancellor requested all Principals to be stringent on the University mandate on attendance (as per the University Examination Rules & Allied Provisions 2017). Regular communication with parents/guardians should be ensured by all in cases of shortage of attendance.

Honourable Vice Chancellor requested all to keep themselves abreast with latest updates from UGC and other Statutory bodies. In this connection he reminded the Registrar to regularly provide all updates from Statutory/Apex bodies to the office of Honourable Vice Chancellor.

Moving on, the Pro Vice Chancellor took up the next item regarding the Action Plan & Strategies for Admissions 2019. She briefed the gathering on the importance of preparing College/Course wise specific Action Plan along with strategies for implementation of the Action Plan. The Pro Vice Chancellor proposed to initiate the planning for Admissions 2019 from October 15th onwards. It was unanimously agreed by all.

She also suggested to the house that subsequent to the preparation of Action Plan, all requirements needed for implementation/execution of the admissions – action plan related to infrastructure, vehicle and other administrative support may be duly submitted to the registrar of the University for further necessary action.

At this juncture, the Honourable Vice Chancellor expressed his disappointment on the poor admissions in 2018. He called upon all Principals to play a more proactive role in the preparation and implementation for Admissions-2019. He informed all that the sole responsibility of admissions shall rest with the Principals of respective colleges. All necessary guidance and support would be available from University authorities. In this direction Honourable Vice Chancellor expressed his concern over the exorbitant expenditure on publication of advertisements and expressed his opinion on minimal expenditure on publication of advertisement in newspapers. Alternatively, he suggested to also send teams to various locations in and around Uttarakhand for admission counseling.

He further requested all Principals to submit the proposed plan and expenditure for the Counseling sessions at various venues along with novel suggestions to boost University admissions. He also informed the house that the Pro Vice Chancellor is preparing a report on Admissions 2018 highlighting the reasons of poor admissions along with the various initiatives adopted in 2018. In this direction, he asked all the Principals to submit their views, if any, for incorporation in the report.

Dr. S. C. Pachauri submitted to the house that Principals should not be held solely responsible for admissions in view of other administrative and academic responsibilities of the respective colleges. On this, the Honourable Vice Chancellor suggested to constitute committees at college



level for smooth and efficient implementation of all proposed activities of the college including admission process. Dire need of proper planning and coordination at college/department level is very important for achieving the set target and goals.

All unanimously agreed to submit a detailed Action Plan for Admissions, Strategies to be adopted with due justification on or before 30th October, 2018.

Dr. Kumud Saklani suggested that students from All India category may be given certain scholarships/discounts so that the difference between the fee structure of Uttarakhand and All India category can be contained in. This may specially be applicable for academically bright candidates. A proposal for the same was asked to be submitted by all Principals.

The Honourable Vice Chancellor pitched in and informed the house that henceforth no remuneration will be provided for examination duties of any kind. The same has been endorsed by the Academic Council of the University.

Discussion ensued on the forthcoming UGC Inspection and the Universities preparedness for the same. Honourable Vice Chancellor emphasized to give TOP PRIORITY to the task and shared the feedback provided by Shri V. A. Bourai subsequent to the first meeting of UGC Inspection Preparation Committee on September 27th, 2018 on the File submitted to UGC by Registrar on August 06th, 2018.

Honourable Vice Chancellor informed all that majority of the corrections/inputs provided earlier (before submission of File to UGC in August 2018) by Shri Bourai and other members of Fact Finding Committee have not been incorporated by the Registrar. Honourable Vice Chancellor appreciated the concern expressed by Shri Bourai in this regard. He being the well-wisher of the University has once again gone through the whole file and pointed out numerous anomalies in the UGC Performa. He highlighted few points raised by Shri Bourai and that all anomalies have been duly communicated to the Registrar. Honourable Vice Chancellor directed the Registrar to incorporate all the corrections and share the inputs provided by Shri V. A. Bourai with the Chairperson of UGC Inspection Preparation Committee by October 10th, 2018.

Proceeding further, Pro Vice Chancellor informed the house that the University has signed an MoU with ICRI, New Delhi to start new courses in Health, Aviation, Management and other allied fields. Out of the proposed 13 courses, 02 courses would be initiated from this academic year viz. M. Sc. Clinical Research & MBA-Hospital Management. She requested the Principals of the concerned colleges to analyze the curriculum and initiate the process of convening BoS at the earliest possible.



With a sense of pride, Honourable Vice Chancellor shared the happy news of signing yet another MoU with GB Pant University of Agriculture & Technology, Pantnagar for Seed Production and subsequent Seed certification.

Ms. Jasline John, Principal - SGRR College of Nursing also informed about the successful completion of the skill development course conducted in association of NGO- Friends of Himalaya. All members applauded the initiative and expressed their happiness for the feat achieved. Honourable Vice Chancellor also shared that an MoU with Himalayan Garhwal University, Pauri, Garhwal is in the offing.

Moving ahead, with the Universities' initiatives towards achieving "Quest for Excellence" the Honourable Vice Chancellor informed that 50 letters to various companies have been sent seeking collaboration in training & placement activities at the University. The target set for collaboration with 200 companies can be achieved with the support of the constituent colleges. In this regard, Pro Vice Chancellor once again requested all Principals to provide details of at least 25-30 top notch companies of their fields to the Training & Placement Officer for further necessary action. She informed that till date only Principal - CA& IT has submitted the names of collaborative companies.

Proceeding further, Honourable Vice Chancellor enquired the Registrar on the status of the Inspection Report viz-a-viz paramedical courses. He further directed the Registrar to issue a letter in this regard within 7 days seeking the approval status of the newly introduced courses at College of Paramedical Sciences.

At this juncture, the Registrar informed all that Regional Employment Officer with his team has approached the University for conducting a Job Fair at University premises tentatively in last week of October. Prior to that, the team proposes to organize a motivational Seminar on Employment Opportunities for the students of the University. The Registrar further informed that the event will be coordinated by Ravinder Kumar, Assistant Professor, College of Basic & Applied Sciences. The Honourable Vice Chancellor directed the Registrar to also include Training & Placement Officer Ms. Neha Nain in planning and execution of the event.

To motivate and orient the students towards their goals, the Honourable Vice Chancellor expressed his desire to organize motivational seminars from eminent speakers of the city. All agreed to the initiative. He further suggested each College should organize minimum two motivational Seminars/Lectures annually and get the Profile of Resource Persons be approved by the Honourable Vice Chancellor. He also urged all principals to ignite enthusiasm amongst all students. UN International Days/ National Days should be celebrated on a regular basis wherein competitions/activities can be organized and Certificate of Appreciation issued to meritorious students. All Principals were asked to submit a list of National/International Days they plan



to celebrate at their college on an annual basis. In this direction Student Councils should be motivated to whole heartedly organize the events.

Supplementing the extra-curricular activities, academic activities should also be encouraged. Honourable Vice Chancellor suggested to mandatorily organize Journal Clubs/ Research Presentations by students and proper documentation of the same may be ensured for future references.

To uplift the academic standards, the Honourable Vice Chancellor informed that in addition to the student feedback on Teaching – Learning Process, a High Powered Committee is being constituted to evaluate the teaching capabilities of all faculty members which will form basis of promotions, increments etc.

Proceeding ahead, Honourable Vice Chancellor once again stressed on the need of complying with all Office Orders issued from time to time. Dr. S. C. Pachauri expressed his inability to submit information asked by the University officials from time to time, owing to shortage of manpower. The Pro Vice Chancellor reminded about the Research Projects to be submitted on or before October 15th, 2018 by all Colleges along with details of Student Councils and Calendar of Activities.

Speaking on good general practices, Honourable Vice Chancellor urged all to submit leave application at least 03 working days prior to the date of absence, failing which, the leave may not be sanctioned. Further in this direction, he also requested all Principals to follow the prevalent administrative practices and duly mark the addressee to which the file has to be dispatched.

Honourable Vice Chancellor once again circulated the Office Order dated 13th November, 2017 from the Honourable Chancellor's Office directing all to follow hierarchy in all official procedures.

Moving ahead, the proposed presentations of Principals were postponed to 12th October, 2018 after the Board of Examination Meeting, due to shortage of time.

There being no other point, the meeting ended with vote of thanks.

Discussion ensured on the guidelines for the functioning of the Internal Compliance Committee. The Presiding Officer requested all to provide their valuable inputs in the next meeting.

- > The minutes of the first meeting of the committee were read out.
- The recommendations made during 1st meeting of the committee were communicated to the registrar SGRRU. The suggestions made are under consideration. Office order pertaining to constitutions of subcommittee has been issued and circulated.
- Since sexual harassment at workplace is a gross violation of women's right to equality it was agreed that prevention is better than punitive action. Men employees of the institution and male students need to be aware that impact rather than intentions is what matters in this context. Thus sensitizing them to proper dignified code of conduct and that any misconduct in this regard may warrant a disciplinary action, is mandatory.
- > The women workers / students of the university should be made aware that a secure working environment is their constitutional right and that they have a platform of redressal and their complaints will be attended to.
- Various suggestions regarding sensitization programmes were discussed by the members of the committee.
- Mr Bahukhandi, agreed to organize a talk by an expert on the subject for the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) and subcommittee members.
- ➤ It was unanimously agreed that handbook on sexual harassment of women at workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013 by Ministry of Women and Child Development will be the guide for functioning of the internal complaints committee of this university.



- > A detailed framework for redressal will be charted as per the recommendations of the above mentioned handbook by Dr. Kritima Upadhyay and Dr. Preeti Mishra.
- > The responsibility of preparing an annual status report with details of number of cases filed and their disposals was given to Dr. Amita Saklani.
- > It was also unanimously agreed to depute Dr. Kirtima Updhyay as the member secretary of the committee.
- ➤ It was decided to meet more frequently till the framework of redressal is completely worded and approved by Hon'ble vice chancellor.

There being no other point, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks.

1. Ms. Minit Arora, Presiding Officer, Anti Women Harassment Cell informed all the girl students that the girls must come forward for reporting any kind of sexual abuse, sexual harassment and matter of gender discrimination. The girls should immediately report any injustice done while attending classes and lab sessions at the school of CA&IT. The Anti Women Harassment Cell will deal with all the cases and complaints of sexual harassment and any other type of harassment of the female students of the school of CA&IT. School of CA&IT is committed in molding a generation which safeguards the virtues of gender equality and equity. The school attempts to uphold the constitutional mandate ensuring the human rights of all those who fall within its jurisdiction. As per the guidelines of UGC, NAAC and the Supreme Court an Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell was established in School of CA&IT to provide a healthy and congenial atmosphere to female students of the School. The girls should immediately report the matter at the first instance.

The following acts come under sexual harassment:

Physical contact and advances, a demand or request for sexual favors, making sexual remarks, showing pomography, any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature, any act falling under the preview of following cases will be considered as an incident of sexual harassment

Know your rights - Sexual harassment is illegal.

Speak up & shout – try telling the person to stop. State clearly and firmly that you want a particular behavior to cease.

Get information and support – If you feel you cannot speak up, ask your friends to help you and bring it to the notice of the school authorities without further loss of time. Inform your parents Keep records that might be useful for pursuing the case.

Please come forward and speak. We will ensure that action is taken.

2. Dr. Manisha Maiduly, Special Invitee, Associate Professor (SMCS), Placement In charge informed all the girl students that the girls should not blame themselves for any such act. Sexual harassment is not something one brings on oneself. It is not a consequence of certain ways of dressing or acting. It is a violation of an individual's right to work and live with dignity.

Do not ignore it. Ignoring sexual harassment does not make it go away. The harasser may misinterpret a lack of response as approval of the behavior.

Do not delay. Delay in action increases the probability that unwanted behavior will continue or escalate.

Do not he sitate to ask for help. Speaking up will prevent others from being harmed.



informed all the girl students that any student can be a potential victim and hence it is important for everyone to understand how to recognize and deal with sexual harassment. Potential consequence for a student seen as a harasser – disciplinary action could be in the form of warning, written apology, debarring entry into campus, suspension for a specific period of time, rustication or heavy fine. A complaint of discrimination or sexual barassment may be lodged by the victim or her parents. A written complaint may be addressed to the Presiding Officer. The complaint will be resolved at School Level. If the complaint is very serious and cannot be resolved at School Level the same will be resolved by the Centralized Internal Complaint Committee formed at University Level under the directions of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Sir. The school has been vigitant about instances of gender discrimination, victimization and abuse, and acts promptly to address/redress any issues that violated the provisions of the sexual harassment Act. Moreover, it plays a proactive role in averting instances of sexual harassment by motivating students to attend the programmes organized by the Women's Cell of the college on gender discrimination, and sexual harassment


