Objectives of SEDG's Cell

(Socially and Educationally Disadvantaged Groups)

1. **To uphold the constitutional rights** of students belonging to Socially and Educationally Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs).
2. **To ensure inclusivity, safety, and security** within Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) for SEDG students.
3. **To provide socio-emotional and academic support**, including mentoring, through effective counselling and monitoring programmes tailored for SEDG students.
4. **To oversee the proper implementation and monitoring** of orientation and bridge courses designed by HEIs to support SEDG students.
5. **To facilitate and monitor the execution** of all programmes developed by HEIs that aim to enhance SEDG students' participation in academic activities.
6. **To ensure the effective implementation** of government policies, including reservation policies, welfare schemes, programmes, facilities, and guidelines designed for SEDG students.
7. **To support the development of outreach programmes** by HEIs to enable SEDG students to access educational and academic opportunities.
8. **To ensure the implementation of legal and preventive measures** against discrimination and atrocities, and to safeguard the rights of students belonging to SEDGs.
9. **To circulate, publicize, and monitor the execution** of all UGC and Government guidelines and directives concerning SEDG students.
10. **To redress grievances and complaints** of SEDG students within 15 days through a dedicated Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC), ensuring the safety, privacy, and dignity of the complainant.
