**Primary Objective of the Activity:** To mitigate the adverse impacts of climate change by enhancing green cover through plantation of native and climate-resilient tree species, while sensitizing students about carbon sequestration, ecosystem restoration, and the role of youth in climate action and environmental sustainability.

Participants will be briefed on the importance of trees in climate regulation, carbon absorption, soil conservation, and biodiversity enhancement. The activity will also include an environmental pledge, sapling protection measures and awareness on post-plantation care to ensure long-term survival and impact.
