Primary Objective of the Activity: The primary objective of “*Nature’s Canvas: Art & Carving Activity*” is to foster creativity and environmental awareness among participants by engaging them in artistic expression using natural materials such as leaves and fruits. The activity aims to deepen participants’ connection with nature by encouraging them to observe the diversity of leaf forms, textures and patterns and transform them into meaningful artworks. It also promotes sustainable practices by utilizing fallen, biodegradable resources, thereby instilling a sense of responsibility towards conservation and eco-friendly living. Additionally, the activity seeks to enhance imagination, fine motor skills and aesthetic appreciation while cultivating mindfulness, appreciation for biodiversity and a positive attitude towards protecting the natural environment in an interactive and experiential manner.

Aligned SDG Goal (s): The activity “*Nature’s Canvas: Art & Carving Activity*” contributes significantly to multiple Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by integrating creativity with environmental consciousness. It supports **SDG 15 (Life on Land):** by promoting awareness about plant diversity, conservation of natural resources and encouraging the use of fallen leaves instead of harming living plants. The activity also aligns with **SDG 13 (Climate Action):** by sensitizing participants to the importance of trees and ecosystems in climate regulation and fostering environmentally responsible behavior. Furthermore, it contributes to **SDG 4 (Quality Education):** by providing experiential, hands-on learning that enhances creativity, observation skills and environmental understanding beyond traditional classroom methods. In addition, the activity supports **SDG 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production):** through the use of biodegradable, natural materials and by encouraging sustainable, zero-waste practices. Indirectly, it also promotes **SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-being):** by engaging participants in relaxing, nature-based creative activities that improve mental well-being and reduce stress. Overall, the activity serves as a holistic approach to education, sustainability and environmental stewardship.

Detailed Description of the Activity: “Nature’s Canvas: Art & Carving Activity” is an engaging, eco-friendly and experiential programme designed to connect participants with nature through creativity and sustainable practices. The activity begins with a brief orientation session where participants are introduced to the importance of plants, biodiversity, and environmental conservation, along with the relevance of sustainable development and responsible resource use. They are guided on ethical practices such as collecting only fallen leaves and avoiding any harm to living plants. Following the introduction, participants explore the surrounding natural area (campus or nearby green space) to collect a variety of fallen leaves differing in shape, size, texture and colour. This collection phase encourages close observation of plant diversity and helps participants appreciate the uniqueness of natural forms. The core segment of the activity involves creating artistic designs using the collected leaves. Participants engage in leaf carving, painting, printing and collage-making to produce creative artworks such as patterns, landscapes, animals or abstract designs. Basic tools and eco-friendly colours may be provided and safety instructions are shared to ensure careful handling during carving. Facilitators guide participants in exploring their imagination while emphasizing the use of biodegradable and non-toxic materials.

After the creation phase, an exhibition or display session is conducted where participants showcase their artwork. Each participant may briefly explain the concept or environmental message behind their creation, promoting reflection, communication and awareness. The activity can also include a short discussion or pledge on environmental protection and sustainable living. Overall, the activity provides a platform for enhancing creativity, fine motor skills and aesthetic sense while fostering mindfulness, teamwork, and a deeper appreciation for biodiversity. It serves as a meaningful blend of art, education and environmental stewardship, making learning enjoyable, interactive and impactful.

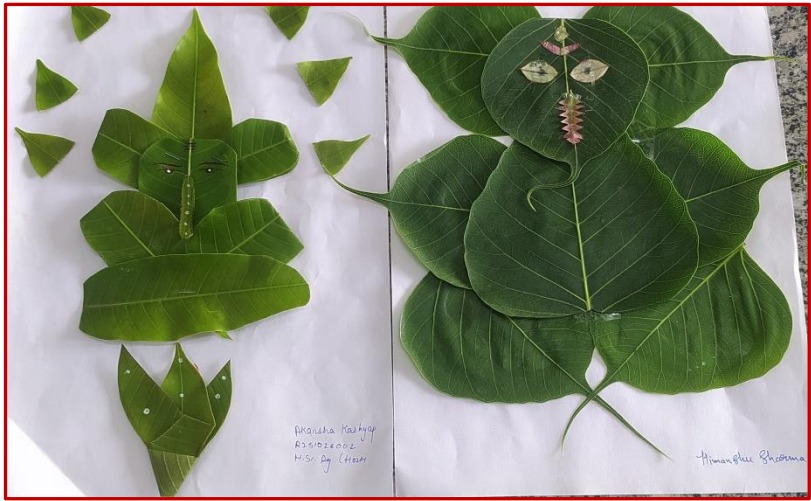
