



Memorandum of Understanding for academic cooperation

between

Indian Institute of Technology Delhi

and

Shri Guru Ram Rai University (SGRRU), Dehradun

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU") is made and entered into on the **27th day of August 2026**.

Between

Shri Guru Ram Rai University, Patel Nagar, Dehradun, Uttarakhand – 248001 (hereinafter referred to as "SGRRU", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors, executors, administrators, and permitted assignees) on the one part;

And

Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi, located at Hauz Khas, New Delhi - 110 016 (hereinafter referred to as "IITD", which expression shall mean and include its Affiliates, successors, and permitted assigns) on the other part.

IITD and SGRRU are individually referred to as "Party" and collectively as the "Parties"

Recital

Whereas,

1. IITD is a public technical university and research institution in Hauz Khas, New Delhi, governed by the Institutes of Technology Act, 1961, and accorded the status of an Institute of National Importance with full academic autonomy.
2. SGRRU Dehradun is a State Private University established by the Govt. of Uttarakhand vide Shri Guru Ram Rai University Act No. 03 of 2017 and recognised by the UGC u/s 2(f) of the UGC Act 1956.56.

Indian Institute of Technology Delhi (IITD) and SGRRU recognise their strengths in research and education in one or more disciplines of science, engineering, medicine, agriculture and social sciences, and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

Therefore, IITD and SGRRU agree to establish a programme for research cooperation in areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU). IITD and SGRRU agree to:

- 1) Explore collaborative research in various areas of engineering, medicine & clinical sciences, including agricultural sciences and social sciences.
- 2) Specific research domains or technical problem areas will be agreed upon by the Parties, and for each activity undertaken, a separate Implementing Agreement will be signed.
- 3) Any intellectual property (IP) generated as a result of joint activities under this MoU shall be jointly owned by IIT Delhi and SGRRU, as per the terms mutually agreed in the Implementing Agreement for each specific activity.
- 4) Transfer or licensing of IP, or technology developed under this MoU, will be documented and governed under a separate agreement, clearly specifying terms, conditions, usage rights and consideration details.
- 5) Any financial commitment associated with joint activities under this MoU will be decided on a case-to-case basis and shall be explicitly mentioned in the Implementing Agreement for that activity.
- 6) No financial obligation shall be implied by this MoU alone unless codified in a signed activity-specific agreement.



IITD and SGRRU agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately agreed upon by the two institutions upon signing the Implementing Agreement for each activity. These terms shall include a description of the proposed activity and financial arrangements.

Each Party will ensure appropriate protection of Intellectual Property Rights jointly generated and owned from cooperation pursuant to the MoU, consistent with their respective laws, rules and regulations to which both parties are committed. In case of joint publication, the use of the name, logo and/or the official emblem of the participants on any publication, document and/or paper will require prior permission from both parties. Further, the Parties shall not assign any rights and obligations arising out of the IPR generated from inventions/activities carried out under the MoU to any third Party without the consent of the other party. Commercialization of technology, if any shall be done jointly through a separate agreement.

All Confidential Information shall remain the exclusive property of the disclosing party.

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five (05) years. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution three months in advance. Once terminated, neither IITD nor SGRRU will initiate any new joint activity. The MoU is not legally binding and all activities will be based on the spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility. However, IITD and SGRRU will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to be completed successfully.

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, the Director, IITD and the Vice Chancellor, SGRRU will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.



This MoU is signed with the approval of the respective academic/administrative bodies.

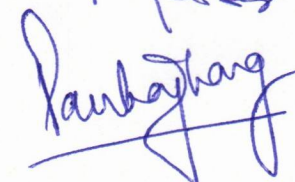
