On the basis of interaction with the faculties and other stakeholders, the following observations and suggestions are given for the quality improvement of education in the University.





## Observations

- Governance and administration under the dynamic and active leadership of Hon'ble Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor is noteworthy and effective.
- University has plenty of land for future development.
- University has large good infrastructure facilities in both the campuses.
- Institute of Medical and Health Sciences, College of Nursing, School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, School of Management and Commerce Studies, School of Humanities and Social Sciences and School of Agricultural Sciences are reasonably good.

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- The Institute of Medical and Health Sciences is catering large number of patients for OPD from Uttarakhand and neighbouring states, which is good for teaching, training and research.
- School of Agricultural Sciences has 50 Acres of land for training and research activities of students and faculties.
- University is providing Seed Grant for Research Purpose to the young Faculties.
- Good Central Instrumental Labs, Centre of Clinical Investigations and Molecular Biology unit exist for training, research and patient care.
- IQAC Cell of University is functional and active.
- Collaboration with industry, institutions and research organisations are required at National and International Level.
- Examination System is very robust, transparent and student centric.
- Extension activities of the university are good, but need more propagation so that stakeholders can be benefitted.
- Infrastructures of Pre-Clinical, Para-clinical and Clinical departments are good.
- The Medical institute is located in the centre of city with good ambience, cleanliness and eco-friendly environment.
- Yoga Department is doing good and they should organized some short term courses for the benefit of the Society.
- Publications by the student pursuing course in Garhwali language are appreciable. Department of Garhwali language is also promoting and persevering Garhwali language and Culture which is good.
- Education and psychology department can have some interdisciplinary projects.
- Scholarship and fee relaxations for socio-economically weaker sections and other various categories are being provided.
- Participation of students in sports and other cultural activities is not worthy but efforts be made to encourage the students to win the medal at state, national and international level.
- It is noteworthy that most of the courses are having value added component in their course content.
- Agriculture faculty is taking up new concept of organic farming.






## Suggestions

- Interdisciplinary research should be undertaken by the faculty.
- School of Education should extend its outreach activities and can use SWAYAM and MOOCS courses .
- Research Publications be published in PEER review journals.
- Research Projects especially from Government funding agencies and efforts to be made more patents and they should be granted.
- Distinguished Alumni should be identified and can be contacted/ invited for lectures and they may be of help in placement.
- For Placement of students, TPO Cell should be strengthened and be made more visible and functional.
- Faculty position in School of Paramedical Sciences, School of Basic and Applied Sciences should be increased.
- Infrastructure modification should be done for Physically Challenged persons in some of the buildings.
- Institute of Medical and Health Sciences should follow all the rules as per Acts, Statutes and Ordinances of the University especially in terms of appointment, promotion and leave rules, etc.
- Central library should have latest books and journals.
- School of Agricultural Sciences can undertake more steps in developing and marketing their products to generate more funds for the University. School can also do farmers training for crop production.
- University should start publishing News letter quarterly by Mass Communication Department.
- Efforts should be made to attract more students across the country.
- There is enough opportunity to develop new indigenous Pharma products and their marketing.
- Institute Ethics Committee should positively promote students and faculty oriented research projects in a timely manner.
- National/International MOU's should be strictly made functional for benefit of students and faculty.
- "Earn while you learn" model should be provided to students to have more number of admission in different courses as an attractive measure.
- Maintenance of Basic and applied Laboratories and expansion of Space for various departments are required.

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
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- Student centric approach to be highlighted for their training and placement.

- More ICT enabled classrooms and Smart classes are to be developed.

  
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
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
