Welcome address

The meeting began with a brief introductory note by the Honourable Vice Chancellor, Dr. Prathapan K. Pillai, and proceeded further by Director IQAC, Dr. Soniya Gambhir to take forward the meeting by presenting the agenda points for discussion and deliberation.

1. Confirmation of Minutes of the 20th IQAC Meeting held on 31st May 2025

Discussion: The minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 31st May 2025 were placed before the members. The members reviewed the same and confirmed that there were no amendments required.

Resolution: The minutes of the 20th IQAC meeting held on 31st May 2025 were confirmed and approved unanimously.

2. Approval of Action Taken Report on the Minutes of the Meeting held on 31st May 2025

Discussion: The Action Taken Report (ATR) based on the decisions taken in the IQAC meeting held on 31st May 2025 was presented before the members. The report was reviewed and discussed.


Resolution: The Action Taken Report was noted and agreed upon by all the members.

3. To Consider the New Initiatives Taken by IQAC

Discussion: The initiatives undertaken by IQAC since the last meeting held on 31st May 2025 were presented before the house. The following initiatives were highlighted:

1. SGRRRIM&HS, College of Nursing, under the aegis of IQAC, organized an *Investor Awareness Program* on 30th June 2025.
2. IQAC organized a workshop on *Cyber Frauds: Awareness and Prevention*.
3. A workshop on *Outcome-Based Education Framework* was organized on 17th July 2025.
4. LIRC, Patel Nagar, under the aegis of IQAC in collaboration with Elsevier, organized a *ScienceDirect Onboarding and Author Workshop* titled "*Elevate Research with ScienceDirect and Publishing Insight*" on 25th July 2025.
5. School of Management and Commerce Studies, under the aegis of IQAC, organized a program on Mental Health and Personality Development titled "*INNERSHIFT*" on 5th August 2025.
6. Department of Physiotherapy, School of Paramedical and Allied Sciences, under the aegis of IQAC, organized a workshop on *Manual Therapy (Clinical Assessment & Treatment Skills for Common Shoulder, Neck, and Back Pain Conditions)* on 22nd September 2025.
7. A workshop on the occasion of World Mental Health Day titled "*Empowering Students' Minds: Navigating Mental Health Challenges in Emergencies*" was organized on 10th October 2025.
8. IQAC organized a Poster Competition followed by an expert session on "*Your Health, Your Power: Breaking the Silence on Breast Cancer*" by Mr. Pankaj Kumar Garg on 27th October 2025.

Resolution: The initiatives taken by IQAC were appreciated and approved by the members.



4. To Discuss the Submission of AQAR (Academic Years 2023–24 and 2024–25)

Discussion: The House was informed that the NAAC portal for AQAR submission is currently closed. Director IQAC requested all Deans to submit both soft and hard copies of the required documents to IQAC so that the AQARs may be uploaded immediately once the portal becomes active.

Resolution: The matter was noted and agreed upon by all the members.

5. To Discuss Strategies for the Implementation of New NAAC Binary Criteria

Discussion: Director IQAC, Dr. Soniya Gambhir, briefed the members about the revised NAAC Binary Accreditation Framework, which is based on the Input–Process–Outcome model and comprises the following ten metrics:

1. Curriculum Design / Curricular Aspects
2. Faculty Resources
3. Infrastructure
4. Financial Resources and Management
5. Learning and Teaching (Process)
6. Extended Curricular Engagements
7. Governance and Administration
8. Student Outcomes
9. Research and Innovation Outcomes
10. Sustainability Outcomes (including Green Initiatives)


It was proposed that IQAC will conduct training and orientation sessions for faculty members and coordinators to ensure effective understanding and implementation of the new binary system. Departments were also advised to align their processes, documentation, and records with the Input–Process–Outcome model.

Resolution: The proposed strategies were noted and agreed upon by all the members.

6. To Discuss the Action Plan for Continuous Quality Improvement in Academic and Administrative Processes

Discussion: The Chair invited suggestions from the members of the House to enable IQAC to formulate and implement an effective Action Plan aimed at continuous quality improvement in academic and administrative processes across all constituent units. After detailed deliberations, the following key improvement measures were suggested and discussed:

1. A minimum of five-day Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) should be conducted regularly to enhance teaching, research, and administrative competencies of faculty members.
2. International collaborations in academics, research, FDPs, student exchange, and joint activities should be given priority to enhance global exposure and benchmarking.
3. The curriculum of all programmes should be reviewed and revised annually, wherever required, to ensure relevance, industry alignment, and compliance with regulatory and outcome-based education frameworks.
4. Apprenticeship / internship components should be included in every academic programme to strengthen experiential learning and employability of students.



5. Comprehensive data related to academics, research, extension activities, and administration should be systematically maintained by every School and regularly submitted to IQAC for monitoring and documentation.
6. Student feedback should be collected twice a year and analyzed to support continuous improvement in teaching-learning and institutional processes

Resolution: The proposed action points for continuous quality improvement were noted and agreed upon by all the members.
