EDINDIA and the Partner together hereinafter referred to as "the Parties"

Whereas, the EDINDIA believes in creating technology-based solutions to impact quality of education at scale. As part of this vision EDINDIA works with the education eco-system and is working closely as an implementation partner with various States and their respective State Council of Education Research and Training (SCERT) entities in India.

Whereas, EDINDIA is a **non-profit entity** dedicated to Teacher and Teacher – student capacity building to enhance teaching skills and technological readiness for an improved learning environment in classrooms by creating tools, solutions and frameworks that empower teachers by leveraging technology to improve the teaching learning process

Whereas, EDINDIA, through its partnership with UNESCO under its Rethinking Learning Programme seeks to build capacities of educators select students through high quality courses on social-emotional learning (SEL) and digital pedagogies leveraging the power of technology;

Whereas, SGRR is **private university** which focuses on achieving the UN Sustainable Development Goal 4.7 towards education for building peaceful and sustainable societies across the world by conducting programmes that promotes the inclusive growth of the society by combining priorities of excellence and relevance:

- a. To promote innovation and entrepreneurship by covering and translating technology into products and processes
- b. To create a robust national innovation system
- c. To encourage the mobility of experts from academia and vice versa

Whereas, the Parties agree to work together to collaborate to enable student teachers based on the framework designed by EDINDIA

Now therefore, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

Article 1 – Objectives

By the present Agreement, EdIndia and the SGRR agree, through joint and concerted cooperation, to:

- 1.1. Facilitate identification of faculty support areas where EdIndia can provide academic inputs and vice – versa. To this objective both parties can collaborate to organize webinars and workshops for teachers and student teachers under the purview of NCT curriculum for the student teacher academic progress.
- 1.2. EdIndia has partnered with UNESCO MGIEP to enable certification of above mentioned participant groups in Digital Teacher pedagogy and Socio Emotional Learning. Under the purview of this agreement facilitative support will be provided to build the capacities of certified master trainers and/or key academic resources drawn out of SGRR's cadre who will in turn organize secondary training for students and other faculties
- 1.3. EdIndia may seek to invite expertise of SGRR faculty time to time.

Article 2 – Key Purpose of this partnership

2.1. SGRRU shall benefit from:

- a. Availing support of EdIndia as offered through topical webinars and student engagement activities such as lesson planning competition or podcasts on pedagogy etc. time to time.
- b. As and when state or inter-state forums draw upon expertise of SGRRU, such engagements will provide
 - i. Publicity to academic strength and resource expertise available with SGRRU
 - ii. Remuneration as per SGRRU university approved norms

2.2. EdIndia shall benefit from:

- a. Being able to impact a larger number of student teachers who are enrolled in SGRRU

- b. Seek inputs and ideas of SGRRU for strengthening the pre-service teacher's capacity building intervention

Article 3 – Obligations of EdIndia

- 3.1. EdIndia agrees to execute the terms of the present Agreement with reference EdIndia roles and responsibilities.
- 3.2. EdIndia will provide support to train Teacher Groups/ master trainers through online workshops on two courses (i) The Digital Teacher (ii) SEL for Teachers as well as academic areas as per curriculum of National Council for Teacher Education.
- 3.3. EdIndia to enable certificates of completion to those trainees who successfully complete the course. EdIndia to offer "letter of appreciation" to the SGRRU as way of acknowledgment.
- 3.4. Costs incurred by EdIndia to address their obligations will be borne by EdIndia and there is **no Financial Implication** to SGRRU.

Article 4 - Obligations of the SGRRU

- 4.1. The SGRRU agrees to execute the terms of the present Agreement with reference SGRRU roles and responsibilities.
- 4.2. The SGRRU agrees to provide a point of contact to work with EdIndia on coordination as deemed necessary to run workshops, online webinar and participant communication efficiently.
- 4.3. The SGRRU will work with EdIndia to collect feedback from participants on how the courses have helped them in improving the design of digital learning interventions and SEL interventions in the classrooms and skills profile.

Article 5 – Media activities

- 5.1. The projects, their conception, their implementation, their development, their impact and their outcome will necessitate informational and promotional activities at the initiative of and on the part of the Parties, separately or jointly.
- 5.2. Each Party is authorized to use the name and the logo and any element of the other's identity, through the use of citations, references to, representations on the occasion of the promotion of projects, of public relations operations, of interviews, of relations with the media (press files, articles, releases etc.) throughout the world. This use, which must adhere to the image of the concerned party, must receive the prior and written consent by the other party when it relates to information activities external to the party concerned.
- 5.3. The media and information support (films, photographic pictures, etc.), as well as all the rights related to them, will belong exclusively to the Party who makes and finances them. They can only be used by the other Party after the latter obtains the prior consent of the proprietary party. Notwithstanding that, the proprietary party can refuse to authorize their use if the rights given up (copyright, trademark) do not cover the foreseen exploitations.

Article 6 – General Conditions

- 6.1 Use of the Name, Emblem or Official Seal of EdIndia or SGRRU

Unless authorized in writing by the opposite party, neither party shall use the name, acronym or official logo of the other party, or any abbreviation of the name thereof, for advertising or any other purposes.

6.2 Status of either party

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as establishing a legal partnership (such as, by way of clarification, partnership liability), joint venture, agency, exclusive arrangement or other similar relationship. Neither SGRRU nor EdIndia shall be authorized to commit any expenditure or other obligations on other party's behalf.

6.4 Conformity with Laws

Both parties agree to respect the laws of the country – India and guarantees that it will not permit any official to receive a direct or indirect profit from this Agreement.

6.5 Settlements of Disputes

All disputes arising out of or in connection with the present Agreement shall be settled by mutual understanding. However, if no amicable settlement can be arrived at, any dispute shall be arbitrated according to the rules defined by law of the land at location - Mumbai.

6.6 Termination

6.6.1 Should either Party fail to meet its obligations, the other Party may terminate the present Agreement upon 3 (three) months' written notice to the other Party. The same will apply with respect to incidents making the realization of the Project extremely hazardous.

6.7 Amendment

This Agreement, including this provision, may not be waived, modified or changed in any manner except by a written amendment signed by each of the parties hereto.

6.8 Non-Exclusivity

It is understood that this Agreement does not confer either Party any exclusivity regarding activities such as those covered by this Agreement, and SGRRU accepts that EdIndia is currently collaborating on similar activities worldwide with other partners.

Article 7 – Notification

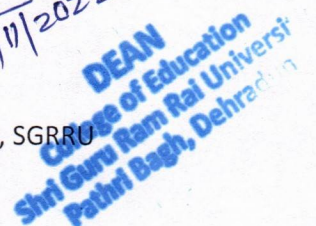

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 21/11/2022 (DATE) between **Shri Guru Ram Rai School of Education, Shri Guru Ram Rai University, Dehradun- 248001** (hereafter, called the 'First Party')

and

अखिल भारतीय महिला आश्रम सरस्वती सोनी मार्ग लक्ष्मण चौक, देहरादून (hereafter, called the 'Second Party').

The *First Party*, and The *Second Party* have agreed to the following terms and conditions of the agreement:

1. The aim of the agreement is to enhance social awareness about sexual harassment, personal hygiene and information about different laws related to woman through Nukkad Natak/Speech/Quiz by **students of the school of education, SGRR University for academic session 2022-2023 for one (01) year.**
2. The provisions ought to be provided by the "Second Party" are given as under:-
 - A. Administrative support in terms of organizers
 - B. Overall Cooperation
3. The provisions ought to be provided by the "First Party" are given as under:-
 - A. Provide awareness program about sexual harassment.
 - B. Students of School of Education shall abide by rules and regulations of the SGRR University.
 - C. Overall cooperation.
4. All the parties have agreed that they will extend every form of co-operation to each other.
5. The agreement shall initially be conducted for academic session 2022- 23(One Year).
6. However, the agreement can be extended to organize more such types of programmes in future. All the parties will be responsible for organizing and managing the program as per the provisions mentioned above.
7. Coordinators from the Second Party will be **Smt. Rekha Aggarwal** and the First Party will be Dean, SGRR School of Education, SGRRU, Dehradun as coordinator Dr. Rekha Dhyani/Mrs. Rakhi Chauhan

8. The agreement shall be made in two identical copies. All the versions are equally valid. Each of the parties of the agreement shall receive one copy of the agreement.
