## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**SHRI GURU RAM RAI UNIVERSITY, PATEL NAGAR, DEHRADUN, UTTARAKHAND**

And

**ACT, 85/14/3 Neshvilla Road, Dehradun, Uttarakhand**

This Memorandum of Understanding (here in after to as MoU) is made on 16<sup>th</sup> March in the year 2018 by and between Shri Guru Ram Rai University, Patel Nagar, Dehradun, Uttarakhand [here in after called SGRRU/first party] and ACT [second party] on the other part (who for the purpose of MoU are here in after collectively referred to as the parties).

SGRRU is a leading University of Uttarakhand, run by SGRR Education Mission, an age old Philanthropic Organisation, proving quality education to its students, at a very low fee structure, whereas ACT is a leading Training Organisation of India, providing Top level Soft Skills and Behaviour Training to top level Executives, Officers, Teachers and Faculties.

The general objective of this MoU is to stimulate and facilitate the development of Faculties at SGRRU by ACT, by conducting a 5- Days Faculties Development Programme (FDP), under CSR (Free of Cost), to each Faculty of SGRRU, in a batch size of 30 Faculties each. ACT would customise a Training Curriculum, in consultation with SGRRU for the FDPs. The schedule and Dates for conducting FDPs would be mutually decided by both the parties.

### **Duration and Termination of the MoU**


1. This MoU is effective as of the date of signatures by the Authorities of SGRR University and ACT.
2. This MoU is valid from the Date of execution by the Parties and shall remain in effect initially for Two years, and thereafter can be renewed.
3. This MoU may be amended at any time by written mutual consent.
4. This MoU may be terminated by either party by the provision of written notice of termination not less than one (1) months prior to the desired termination date. However, both parties agree that all continuing obligations to students, staff, funding bodies or other entities are met in full subsequent to the notice of termination.
5. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the rights or obligations of either party regarding any binding offer or firm obligation approved and agreed to either party prior to the termination date.
6. In event of any dispute/s arising between the parties hereto, it shall be endeavor of both the parties to first make an attempt to resolve the dispute amicably by mutual discussion and deliberation, falling which the dispute shall be referred to Arbitration. The Arbitration shall be conducted as per the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and amendments thereto. The Arbitral Tribunal shall consists of Arbitrator (s), to be appointed mutually by both the parties. The Jurisdiction of Arbitration shall be Dehradun. The language of Arbitration shall be English. The Award of Tribunal shall be final and binding on the both parties.





This MoU has been executed into originals, one of which has been retained by the first party and the other by the second party. In witness where of the parties have executed this MoU and represent that they approve, accept and agree to terms contained herein.






