



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING(MOU)**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 7/12/, 2023.

**BY AND BETWEEN**

**SCHOOL OF EDUCATION, PATHRI BAGH CAMPUS** affiliated with Shri Guru Ram Rai University, Chamanpuri, Govt. Industrial Estate, Patel Nagar, Dehradun, Uttarakhand-248121 (hereafter, called the 'First Party').

and

**RAMANUJAN COLLEGE**, affiliated with University of Delhi located at Kalkaji, New Delhi – 110019 (hereafter, called the 'Second Party').

**WHEREAS:**

1. The First Party has approached the Second Party to conduct faculty training program for the interested faculty of the First Party.
2. The Second Party is interested in conducting a faculty training program namely "Psychological Skills for Teaching and Learning" for the First Party.

Both the parties agrees to the terms and conditions as laid down below:

1. The aim of the agreement is to enhance the capacity building of faculty members/ research Scholars by organizing **online one Week Faculty Development program on "Psychological Skills for Teaching and Learning"** from **24<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> December, 2023** with a registration fee of total INR 20,000/- to be borne by trainees. The registration fee will be **non-refundable**.
2. The program shall initially be **conducted with an online One Week Faculty Development Program on "Psychological Skills for Teaching and Learning"** from **24<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> December, 2023**.
3. However, the agreement can be extended to organize more such types of programmes in future. All the parties will be responsible for organizing and





managing the online training program as per the provisions mentioned above.

4. Coordinators from the First Party will be **Dr. Balbir Kaur S/o \_\_\_\_\_ R/o Dehradun** and the Coordinator from the Second Party will be **Dr. Ashish Kumar Shukla S/o \_\_\_\_\_ R/o \_\_\_\_\_** Ramanujan College, University of Delhi, Delhi.

5. The provisions ought to be provided by the "First Party" are given as under:-

- A. Administrative support in terms of organizers
- B. Detailed Programme Report
- C. The first party will ensure the participation of atleast 20 participants from their institution. Details of the participants should be provided to the second party. Alternatively, the first party will pay an amount of INR 20,000 towards the organization of the Course.
- D. Publicity and Participation will be managed by both the parties. (First and Second party).
- E. Overall Cooperation

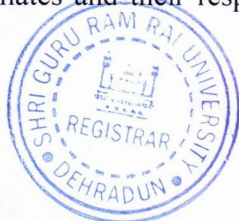
6. The provisions ought to be provided by the "Second Party" are given as under:-

- A. LMS Portal development and maintenance
- B. Consultancy to conduct the FDP
- C. Honorarium to Resource persons
- D. Registration fee will be collected by the Second party only
- E. Participation E-Certificate.
- F. Technical inputs regarding sessions and modules.
- G. Overall cooperation

7. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Courts at Dehradun shall have exclusive jurisdiction to entertain any disputes arising out of relating to this Agreement to the exclusion of all other courts.

8. In case of any dispute arising out of this agreement, the parties can appoint an arbitrator mutually which shall be subject to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The seat of the arbitrator shall be **Dehradun**.


9. Either Party hereby indemnifies, keep indemnified, hold harmless and defends the other Party, its affiliates and their respective employees, officers, and directors, against any



claim by a third party including but not limited to damages, costs, expenses as a result of such claim, arising out of or related to breach of the material terms and conditions of this Agreement;

10. Upon the termination or expiration of this Agreement, all the **Second Party's** rights under it shall cease and no payment whatsoever shall be due to **Second Party** for loss of goodwill, anticipated profits and any other claims or losses in respect of such termination.
11. Under no circumstances shall either Party be liable to the other for indirect, incidental, consequential, special, or exemplary damages arising from or in connection with this Agreement. Under no circumstances shall either Party be liable to the other for any loss of revenue or anticipated profits or lost business.
12. That, the **First party** may terminate the agreement Exparte and without notice to the **Second party**, on serious violation of laid down terms & conditions of the agreement or on breach of trust by the latter which deemed to be detrimental to the interest of the institute. All the same, the second part may be given an opportunity for defense on their alleged omission and commission.
13. This agreement shall come into effect on the date of signing of this agreement by the both parties or authorized representatives of the **First & Second Party**.


