By Govt. of Uttarakhand, vide Shri Guru Ram Rai University Act No. 03 of 2017) acting through Vice Chancellor, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successor, administrators, assigns or legal representative.

And

India (herein after referred as "UCOST") acting through Director General, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successor, administrators, assigns or legal representatives.

Both Institutions state that they:

Both Institutions state that they:

Recognize the value of academic interchange and lively engagement in an international scholarly community by members of academic and research institutions.

Discern the significance and importance of collaboration in the pursuit of international cooperation and awareness by each institute's interest in and need for establishing and sustaining such cooperative ties.

Confirm the significance of the furthering of knowledge and the creative role of the international scholarly communication and collaboration in the development and dissemination of learning and earch.

Hence in the spirit of promoting exchanges between them in all pertinent area of science education, research and service, both the institution agree as follows:-

A. General objectives

i. To exchange information, articles, reports and tenching material in order to support the educational & research programs of each institution in the field of the Professional Competencies.

To strengthen and encourage communication and collaboration in education and research between members of the two institutions, particularly with respect to the Professional Competencies program.

iii. To simulate contacts between investigators in science from the two institutions.

To develop scientific projects for collaborative research, teaching, technical cooperative, evaluation and publication. The human and technical resources which will contribute in designing and operating the program shall be specified from each institution. Also, the mechanism and action to evaluate, supervise and utilize the products of the aforementioned programs, shall be jointly established.

To promote bilateral co-operation in scientific research and education in different faculties involving.

- a. Teaching and exchange of scientific researchers
- b. Organizing lecture, seminars and scientific meetings
- c. Development of projects of common interest.
- d. Visit of faculty and students for the mutual benefits of both institutions
- e. Co-operation in conduct of research (except finances).

B. Scholar Exchange and Education; Collaboration.

- i. To develop learning opportunities through courses, seminars workshops, and other means from both institutions to pursue activities related to scholars' academic program, particularly with respect to the development of a Professional Competencies curriculum adapted for use at respective institution.
- ii. To facilitate visit by students between institutions vice versa.
- To facilitate the exchange of science faculty/ research members and visiting scholars dedicated to participate in teaching and research.
- iv. In all cases, the exchange of faculty members / research and visiting scholars will occur within the regulation of each institution and will take place on an individual basis.

C. Legal Conditions,

i. This MoU is a statement of intent and in no way intended to create legal or binding obligation on either Institution and serves prily as a record of the institutions' current

intention to enhance the relationship of the institutions going forward. This MoU does not create legally enforceable rights claim, interest, duty, or obligation in favour of either of the party as against other party.

- ii. All cooperation is on self-finance basis and none of the institutions is obliged to support each other financially for the purpose of this MoU.

- iv. All students and faculty exchanges will be approved at the departmental and faculty level through the appropriate mechanisms as per defined procedures.
- v. For the purpose of coordinating visits, correspondence and projects, exchange visitors will communicate with a counterpart in the institution where cooperative research or teaching occurs.
 - vi. All risk procedures within the policy structure as defined by concerned institution will be carried out and reported on before any exchanges take place.
 - vii. Before any particular cooperative project or program is initiated, all financial detail shall be negotiated specially allocation to effect by administration authorities. Notwithstanding anything contained in this MoU, each institution will remain responsible for their own initiative in matters of finance.
 - Cooperative projects requiring financial support shall not be initiated in the expectance of support by either institution before such funding has been explicitly agreed to and committed by written consent and a further agreement would be required.
 - ix. This MoU shall come into effect for a period of (10) Years upon the signature of both parties and shall be renewed with their mutual consent and signature. It may be extended by written agreement of both partners.

- 7. In case of any dispute of difference relating to this MoU, both parties agree to resolve the same through mediation before going to arbitration to litigation.
- xi. Either party may terminate this MoU with six months advance written notice to other party, Competent courts in Uttarakhand shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
- xii. Both parties of this MoU agree to act in good faith and in a spirit of mutual understanding and accommodation to facilitate achievement of goals set under this MOU.
