Introduction of the topics, what is gender sensitization, why is it needed, gender audit

A small activity where participants were asked to create a pair, opposite gender partners were awarded 10 points where was same gender were awarded with 5 points. Within 2 minutes they had to introduce themselves to their partners. After that they were not allowed to talk.

5 questions were asked from each pair and another person had to answer for this partner to check their awareness about their partner.

Q1: Name of the father.

O2: Name of the mother.

Q3: Place he/she belongs.

O4: Favourite colour.

Q5: Any waterbody where they live.

The purpose of the activity was to prove that opposite genders are not comfortable in commutating with opposite genders. Thus there is a need of gender sensitization.

A PowerPoint presentation was done, on topics like Gender analysis, Gender Concerns, Gender Issue.

Participants were made aware of ICC and actions taken in case of sexual harassment.

An interactive activity where a common gender stereotype was given to the audience and were asked to debunk or present their views, their anecdotes relating to a particular gender stereotype.

The purpose of this activity was to make opposite genders aware of the stereotypes.

4 group were made, each group was were given 4 topics like Vishaka guidelines, POSCO, sexual harassment etc. and were asked to perform a small play on the same.

Students were asked to do their research on the topics and create a storyline, charts.



Team #1 : Performed on the topic of Vishaka Guidelines, how it came into existence.

Team #2 : Performed on the topic of how career choice shouldn't be effected by gender stereotypes.

Team #3: Performed on the topic of Acid attack victims.

Team #4: Performed on the topic of sexual harrasment in school/colleges.





Each team performed very well, the team which performed on Vishaka Guidelines was awarded first place.
